

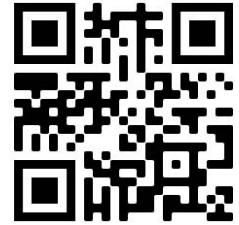


Elephant Toothpaste Activity

Materials:

- Empty 1-Liter Soda Bottle
- 4 Ounces of 6% Hydrogen Peroxide
- Dish Soap
- Food Coloring
- Package of Dry Yeast
- Warm Water
- Funnel
- Small Mixing Container
- Free Printable – Elephant Toothpaste Label (Available on our Website)
- Glitter (Item #18584)



1. Empty Bottle

Thoroughly clean a 1-liter soda bottle. Remove soda label and replace with our free printable of the Elephant Toothpaste Label.

2. Add Hydrogen Peroxide

Using your funnel, pour 4 ounces of 6% hydrogen peroxide into your soda bottle. Please note that this is a higher concentrated solution than what is often found at grocery stores. It can be found cheaply at beauty supply stores.

3. Add Additional Ingredients

Add a couple squirts of liquid dishwashing soap to your bottle. Next, add a couple of drops of food coloring. For best results, use a max of two colors. Add glitter for a sparkly, "cleaning" effect (optional).

4. Mix Yeast

In a small container, mix 1 packet of dry yeast with 4 tablespoons of warm water. Mix thoroughly.

5. Pour!

Quickly pour your yeast mixture into your filled soda bottle (do not use a funnel). Watch your elephant toothpaste quickly form and ooze out of its tube!

6. Play

Your elephant toothpaste may be a little warm after the reaction. Let it cool then have fun exploring your foamy, glittery creation!
