



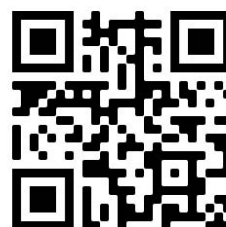
Winter Snow Bulletin Board

- Sky Blue Kraft Roll Paper (Item #17442-SB)
- White Paint (Item #33301-WH)
- Black Paint (Item #33301-BK)
- Foam Paint Roller (Item #87931)
- Paintbrush (Item #84706)
- Stapler (Item #99888)
- Cotton Balls (Item #42657)
- Crayons (Item #61320)
- Markers (Item #61325)
- Cotton Batting
- Large Sheet of Cellophane
- Letters

1. Prepare the Board

Staple a piece of blue kraft paper, large enough to cover the entire space, on the bulletin board. Paint trees on the right and left side.

2. Make the Globe

Use the cotton batting, cotton balls, cardboard letters, and cellophane to assemble the snow globe.

3. Prepare the Snowflakes

Have children cut out the free snowflake printable, draw their favorite winter activity, and staple it on the board for all to enjoy!
