This is a 3-hour course worth .3 CEUs, and can be used to meet the training requirements to earn or renew your Child Development Associate® (CDA®) credential. Course content is aligned with the CDA® Subject Area 2: Advancing children's physical and intellectual development.

[Learn Every Day: Infants, Toddlers, Twos: Learning Every Day through the Senses](#) (Item #28064, \$30.00/participant). This course offers a brief overview of the principles, concepts, and foundations of infant/toddler development. Participants will explore how they, as caregivers, can enhance sensory development and provide modifications for infants, toddlers, and twos who need additional supports. Potential issues of sensory integration issues are also explored. Course content is based on Kaplan Early Learning Company's *Learn Every Day™ The Program for Infants, Toddlers, and Twos* curriculum. This is a 2-hour course, worth .2 CEUs, and may be used to meet the training requirements to earn or renew your Child Development Associate® (CDA®) credential. Course content is aligned with the CDA® Subject Area 8: Understanding principles of child development and learning.
