

# Sensory Apple Trees

Encourage fine motor and science skills with this sensory activity that celebrates the harvest of fall.

For ages 3 and up  
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# Sensory Apple Activity

## Materials:

- Pinecones
- Wooden craft spools (Item #32319)
- Pompom value pack (Item #31594)
- All-purpose glue (Item #47358)
- Green yarn (Craft Yarn Item #32109)

## Optional Materials:

- Hot glue gun (Item #18570)



## Process:

1. Talk to the children about apple trees and the different colors of apples.
2. Precut several strips of green yarn. Give each child one to wrap their tree with. You should not need glue since the yarn will "stick" to the grooves of the pinecone.
3. Let children pick out several pompoms to represent their apples.
4. Glue bottom of the pinecone to one end of the wooden spool. This creates your tree base.
5. Ask the children to glue the pompom apples to their tree and allow to dry.
6. Display apple trees throughout classroom.

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
